ENVIRONMENTAL ACTIVITIES

The following are defined as environmental activities under the Environmental Protection Act 1994:

- * Abrasive blasting
- * Animal Housing (i.e. commercial kennels)
- * Asphalt manufacture
- * Boat building or repairing
- * Boiler making or engineering workshop
- * Concrete batching (including concrete products) <100 t/year
- * Crematorium
- * Extraction of rock and other materials (i.e. sand, gravel, loam) <5,000 t/year
- * Incineration facilities for vegetation, clean paper or cardboard
- * Metal forming (i.e. panel beating, construction of steel tanks)
- * Metal recovery (i.e. scrap metal yard, wreckers)
- * Metal surface coating (i.e. galvanising, spray painting) <30,000 t/year
- * Motor Racing
- * Motor Vehicle Workshop
- * Pet, Stock and aquaculture food manufacture
- * Petroleum product storage >500,000L
- * Plastic manufacture >1t/year
- * Poultry farming
- * Printing works
- * Seaplane mooring or marina
- * Screening of materials (i.e. washing, crushing, grinding, sizing) <5,000 t/year
- * Wood product manufacturing (i.e. cabinet making)

CLASS 3 DANGEROUS GOODS STORAGE

Class 3 goods includes but is not limited to the storage and / or distribution of the following:
Agricultural chemicals, Kerosene, Shellite, Diesel, Heating Oil, Unleaded Petrol, Degreaser, Leaded Petrol

FOOD PREMISES
