Emerald CBD Revitalisation

It is full steam ahead for the CBD revitalisation project, which is set to reach major milestones over the coming weeks.

Central Highlands Regional Council Mayor, Peter Maguire said the project is progressing well and the community would continue to see significant changes throughout the CBD.

“Roadworks have continued throughout the CBD and the last of the unsealed areas will be primer sealed today. The asphalt will be laid next week and the centre garden kerbing will start,” Cr Maguire said.

“The cooperation of the Emerald community has helped the project immensely and I would like to extend my thanks to everyone,” he said.

Cr Maguire said work had started along a portion of the south western side of Anakie Street to widen and flatten the footpath area.

“Also in Anakie Street, the Cenotaph will be completed next week with the fountain and plaques adding the finishing touches,” he said.

“The concrete along Egerton Street is nearing completion while the stormwater upgrade from Borilla Street to the Golf Course being completed this week.

“The final piece of artwork ‘Hands on the Wall’ has arrived and will be installed near the entrance to the Council building in coming weeks,” Mr Maguire said.

“I would like to thank the businesses in the CBD and the Emerald community for their patience and cooperation during this project.”
