Emerald CBD Revitalisation

Work is set to continue as the CBD Revitalisation project progresses with results becoming more evident each day.

Central Highlands Regional Council Mayor, Peter Maguire said the project is moving forward with the community to see more significant changes over the coming weeks.

“As the community may have noticed, asphaltting along Egerton Street has commenced and we anticipate the work will be completed early next week,” Cr Maguire said.

“Once the asphaltting has been completed we will move onto constructing new gardens around the existing trees in the centre parking.

“These gardens will then be planted with a variety of different flora.”

Cr Maguire said it was great to see that new works are commencing.

“It was a great success to see the refurbishment of the Cenotaph area completed before Vietnam Day on the 18th August for the memorial service,” he said.

“This is an important day in Australia’s history, so it was vital to have this work completed on time.

“We are now moving onto installing feature lighting throughout the CBD, which will be carried out over the coming weeks.

Cr Maguire said further changes will also be seen throughout the CBD with changes to parking in some areas.

“Some parking areas in the CBD will be changed from parallel parking to noise-in angle parking.

“It is still anticipated that the CBD project will be completed within deadlines and budget” Cr Maguire said.
