Whether your sport is located on your land, Council's land or land belonging to Another entity you are the custodians of valuable community infrastructure and have a part to play in maintaining these assets in the best possible condition for the benefit of your members, present and future, and the broader community.

Consider the following:

Does your committee have a formal maintenance program, not only for your infrastructure but for other things like playing and canteen equipment as well?
Who does what and when?

Do you have a clear indication of what your annual facility running costs are and budget accordingly?
Do you know if your facilities meet acceptable playing, health and safety and legislative standards?
How are you planning for future infrastructure needs, upgrades or replacement and how are they going to be paid for?

If a funding body asked you to **detail** ongoing operational and maintenance costs for the new/improved/replacement infrastructure your club is seeking plus how you will meet those costs, could you?

If your answer to any of these basic questions are 'no', 'no idea', 'in a fashion', 'ask Council' or 'get funding' then you seriously need to attend the Facility Management workshop.

The workshops provide information and tools to assist committees to better understand the range of issues surrounding facility management, including maintaining playing surfaces, clubhouses, amenities, lighting, storage, fencing, spectator facilities, plant and equipment.

We'll have interactive discussions and group exercises and you'll be given a range of simple templates and tools along with tips on best practice methods.
